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Guidelines for “Dress for Success” 2010-2011

1. Students may wear khaki or navy blue pants, shorts, or capris. Girls may also wear red, navy, khaki, or white sleeveless jumpers, polo style dresses, or skirts. Navy blue does NOT include blue jeans. Students are not allowed to wear wind pants or sweatpants. Shorts, skirts, and dresses must be at least finger tip length. (Finger tip length means that when a student straightens their arm next to the side of their leg, the shorts, skirts, or dresses should not be shorter than the tip of their longest finger)
2. Pants, shorts, capris, or skirts with belt loops must be worn with a belt. Girls may use ribbon belts if they choose.
3. Belts in brown, black, or school colors may be worn.
4. If a student chooses to wear socks, leggings or tights, they must be white, khaki, navy, red, or skin-tone in color. Designed socks, leggings, or tights are only acceptable if they are in school colors (no color combinations other than white, red, royal, and navy).
5. Hair accessories must be in school colors.
6. Collared polo style shirts must be solid in color. Shirt colors include: red, royal, navy blue, or white. Gray and black are not school colors.
7. Polo shirts should be plain unless a small Jefferson logo is located on the left pocket area.
8. Jefferson T-shirts or Jefferson Elementary School T-shirts can only be worn on announced spirit days and announced special reward days. (These guidelines and dates are located in the agenda)
9. Undershirts and full button cardigans (sweaters that are full button) should be solid in color. These colors include: red, royal, navy blue, or white. Pull-over sweaters are not allowed.
10. Jackets (if you choose to wear them in the classroom) should follow our color combinations ~ red, khaki, royal blue, navy blue, or white. Jackets do not have to be solid. Reminder: Gray and black are not school colors.
11. Sweatshirts (if you choose to wear them in the classroom) should be solid in color. These colors include red, royal, navy blue, or white. However, a Jefferson logo can appear on the front or back.
12. Colored spray is not allowed in hair.
13. Tennis shoes are required on P.E. days. Shoes with attached wheels are not allowed.
14. NO rolling book bags. Book bags with wheels damage the lower portion of the walls and flooring.
15. Should your child arrive dressed inappropriately, we will call parents to bring a belt or change of clothing. Repeated violations will be considered a discipline issue. If your child requires an item of clothing from the School's Clothes Closet during the day, please wash the item and return it to the school the following day.

Guidelines for Spirit Day Dress

(these dates will be announced and posted in the agenda)

1. Students may wear blue jeans OR (red, white, navy, royal, khaki) jeans, shorts, skirts, skorts, capris, etc. Remember: “skinnies” are not allowed.
2. Shorts, skirts, and skorts should be solid in color and remain knee length. Plaids and stripes are not permitted.
3. Gym shorts (at knee length) are permissible.
4. Wind pants and sweat pants (in SOLID school colors) are also permissible.
5. Tops should be t-shirts (long or short sleeve) or sweat shirts that are predominately solid in color. Tie-dies, striped shirts, and plaid shirts are NOT permitted. The base color of the t-shirt or sweat shirt should be red, royal, navy, or white in color. Sleeveless shirts are NOT permitted.
6. The t-shirt and/or sweat shirt may have a logo on the front and/or back. However, the logo MUST reflect a Jefferson or Dragon logo.
7. Blouses and other style shirts are not allowed on spirit days.

Free Dress Day Guidelines

(this date will be for individual pictures in the spring – NOT in the fall)

1. Shirts or dresses with spaghetti straps, tanks, or halters are NOT permitted.
2. Dresses, shorts, and/or skirts should be knee length.
